# What is the David Taylor Mentoring Program?

- The David Taylor Mentoring Program (the “Program”) is part of the José M. Berrocal Institute for Economics and Finance.
- The Berrocal Institute, founded in 2002, is a subsidiary of the Government Development Bank for Puerto Rico (“GDB”).
- The Berrocal Institute provides undergraduate and graduate students an opportunity to work for two months during the summer at various governmental agencies and departments.
- Students benefit from the opportunity to understand the importance of working in the public sector and its impact on business as well as the economic future of Puerto Rico.





# How can you benefit from the David Taylor Mentoring Program?

- 2 participants will work for 1 calendar year at GDB (starting in January 2013), acquiring experience and knowledge in the areas of treasury, fiscal policy, financing and capital market transactions.
- Participants will also benefit from attending finance-related seminars, conferences, and forums in the United States and in Puerto Rico.
- Participants will also have the opportunity to learn from best practices utilized by investment firms and banks in Wall Street through close collaboration with these.
- Participants will receive competitive compensation.





# Who was David Taylor?

- Born in England, David “Dave” Taylor graduated from St. Andrews University in Scotland with a bachelor’s degree in mathematics. He began his career as a tax analyst at Mudge Rose in New York.
- Dave’s banking career spanned 23 years, having worked in the municipal banking departments of major investment banks like Bank of America, UBS and Morgan Stanley.
- David joined the GDB in February 2009 to structure capital market transactions during one of the challenging economic times in Puerto Rico’s recent history .
- David, a great mentor, friend and GDB’s former senior vice president of capital markets, passed away unexpectedly on September 23, 2011 at the age of 52.

**In 2012, GDB celebrates its 70th anniversary, and it is honoring Mr. Taylor’s contributions to the public sector and to Puerto Rico by dedicating the Program in his honor.**

# Who can apply for the David Taylor Program?

- ✓ Those born in Puerto Rico and/or residents of Puerto Rico
- ✓ Candidates must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA, without exception
- ✓ Fully bilingual in Spanish and English
- ✓ Those with a bachelor or post-graduate degree(s) and/or those currently pursuing graduate studies in Finance, Economics, Mathematics, Business Administration, or other related areas





# What are the requirements in order to apply to the David Taylor Program?

- ✓ Submit completed application by October 31, 2012, in order to be considered for the January 2013 program
- ✓ Submit 4 written essays
- ✓ Submit official transcripts (undergraduate and graduate, if applicable)
- ✓ Complete the interview process
